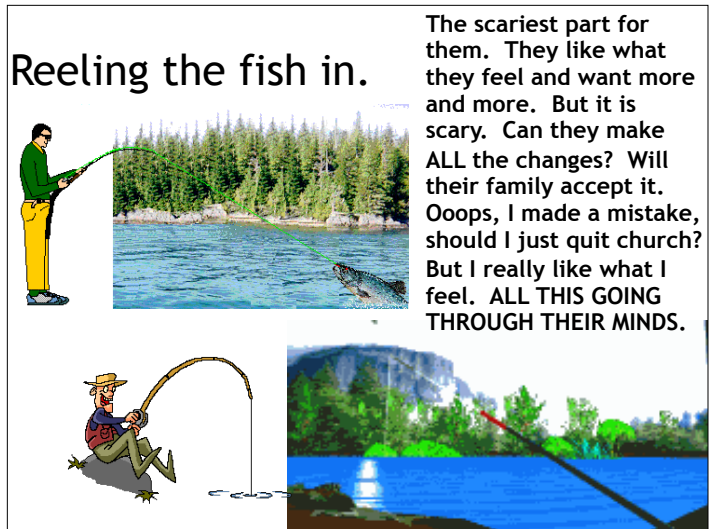
Teach Bible studies

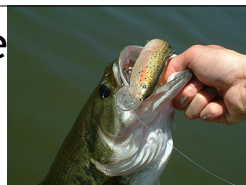
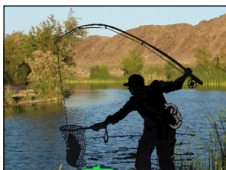
